Vineyard area: 1,25 acres

**Soil types:** Sandy-clay

**Planting density:** 6 500 vines /ha **Average age of the vines:** 5 years

**Grape variety:** Malbec

Cultivation method: rational cultivation

**Pruning:** Poussard pruning method

Soil management: natural grass cover every other row and tillage

Yield: 40-45 hl per hectare

**Harvest:** picking by hand using trays.

The grapes are sorted in the vineyard and in the cellar.

The harvest is protected in a refrigerated cellule.

Winemaking technique and barrel ageing: cold soak skin contact maceration.

Integral vinification and ageing in amphorae

Annual production: around 900 bottles
