Owners: ALLOIN Family

Vineyard Area: 1/2 hectares (3,7 acres)

Soil types: Sandy-clay soils

Planting Density: 6100 vines per hectare

Average age of the vines: 35 years

Cultivation Method: sustainable agriculture

Soil Management: Natural and permanent grassing one row out of two and tillage.

Grape varieties: 50% Merlot, 50% Cabernet Franc

Yield: 40 hl/ ha

Harvest Picking: By hand

Winemaking process: Direct pressing, 18-20°C

Maturation in stainless steel vats

Annual production: 1800 bottles - 600 magnums
